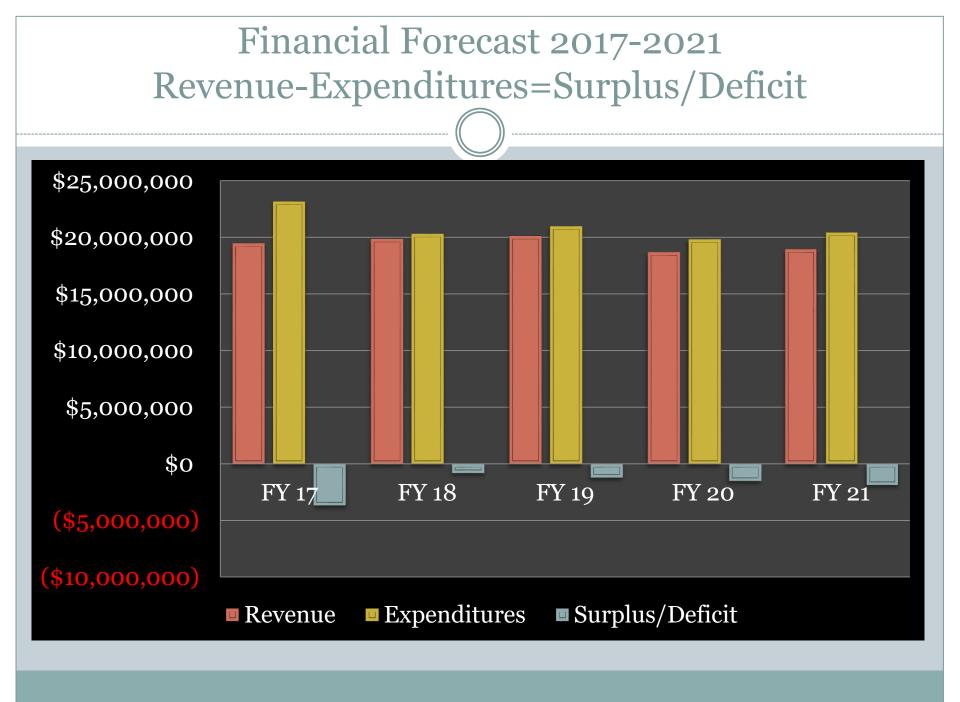
#### **Efficiency for Taxpayers**

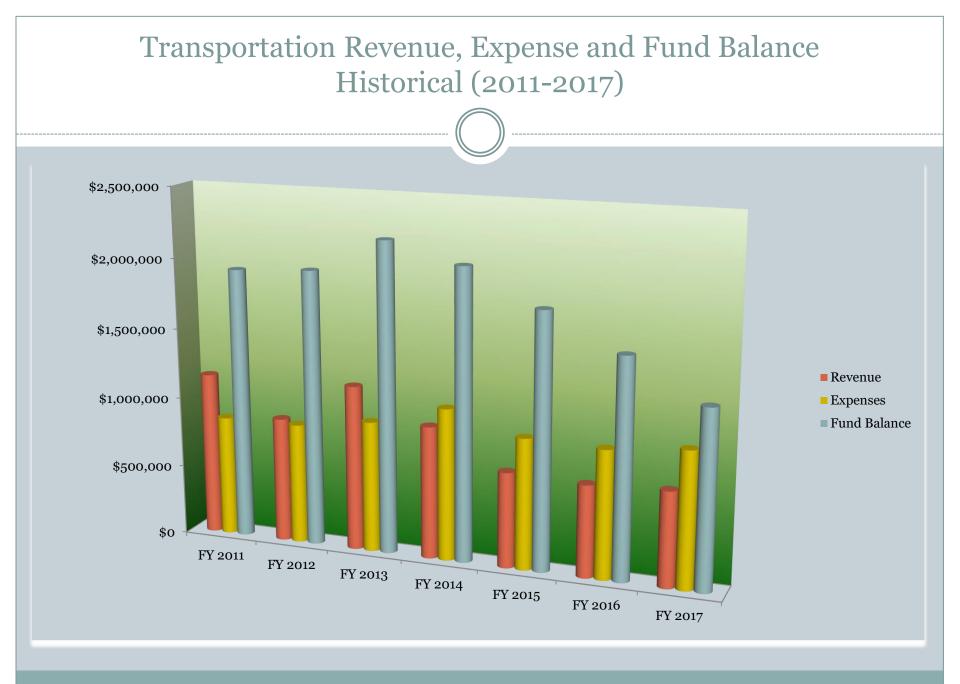


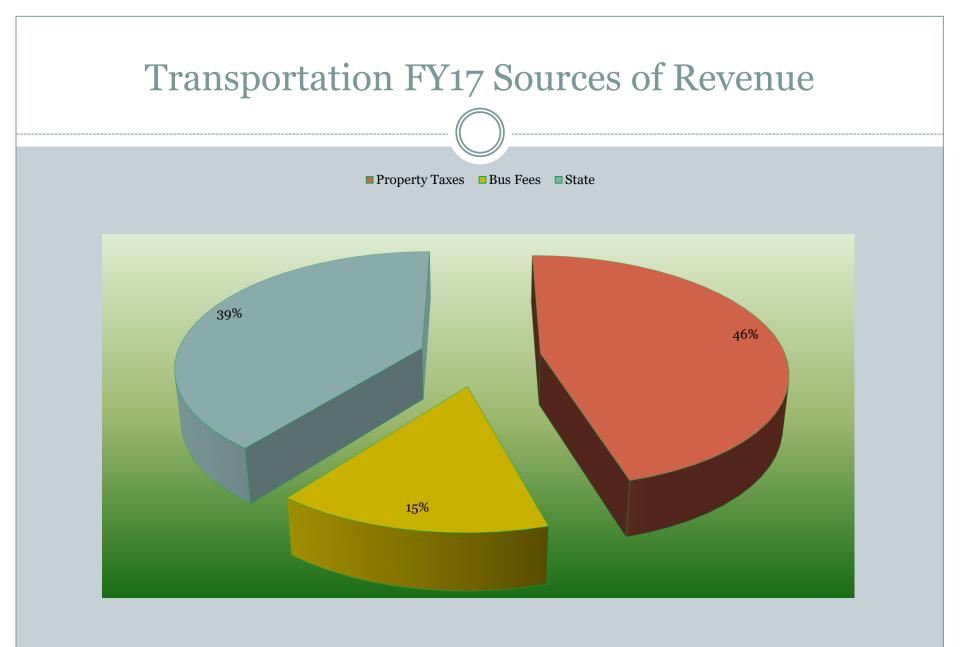

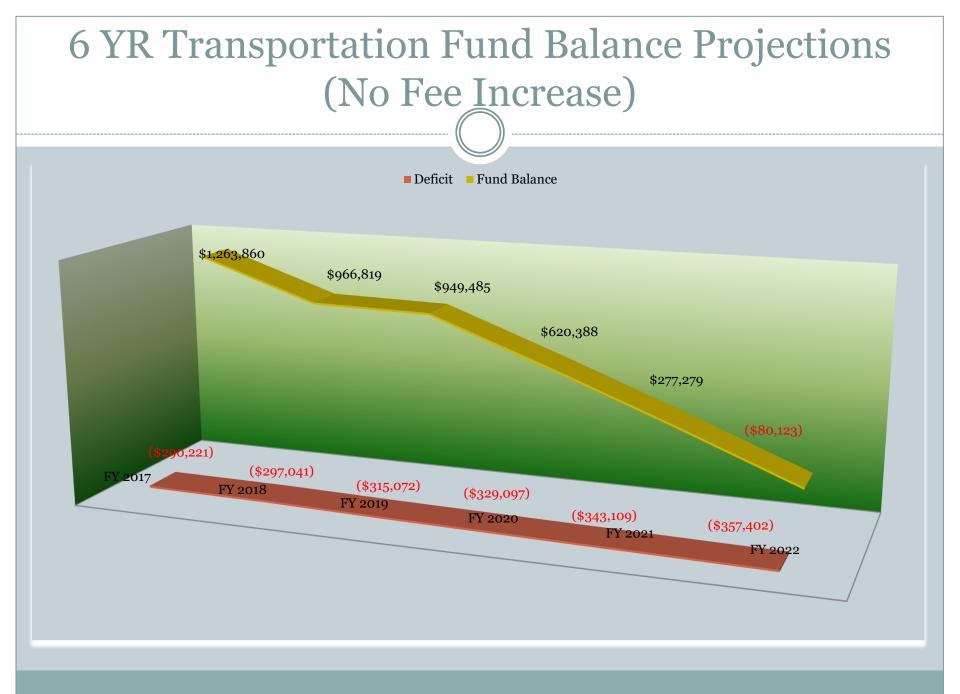
- Expenditures continues to outpace our revenue streams

- Property Tax Freeze

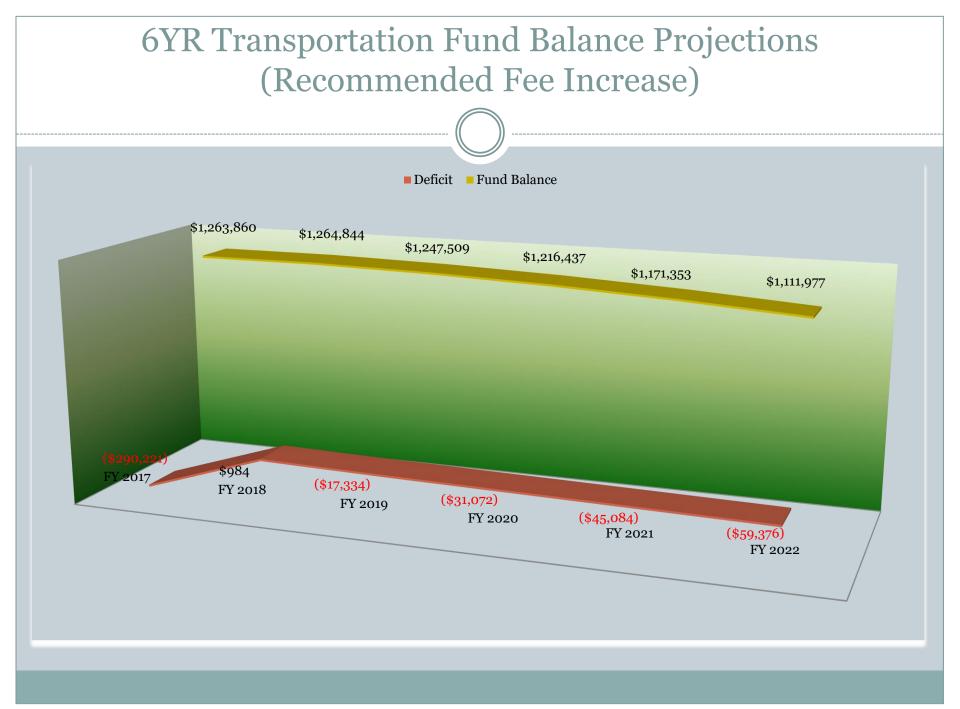
