Sealed Bids for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment and appurtenances necessary for the construction of the Track Improvements at Mary Persons High School, 300 Montpelier Avenue, Forsyth, GA 31029 will be received by the Monroe County Board of Education (MCBOE) in the Conference Room of the MCBOE Office at 25 Brooklyn Avenue, Forsyth, Georgia 31029 until 2:00 P.M. local time, on Thursday, April 4, 2019, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Late responses will be returned unopened and will not be considered.

The Project consists of all milling existing asphalt, new asphalt paving, new urethane track surfacing and all other work included in the Bid Documents.

The Contract Time is 90 calendar days for the project. Liquidated damages in the amount of \$100.00 shall be assessed for each day the work extends beyond the Contract Time.

The work in the Contract will be awarded on the basis of the total sum bid for the project.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, prepared on the form of Bid Bond attached to the Contract Documents, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount of 10% of the Bid.

The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid.

All necessary permits for this project are expected to be acquired prior to the Bid Date.
