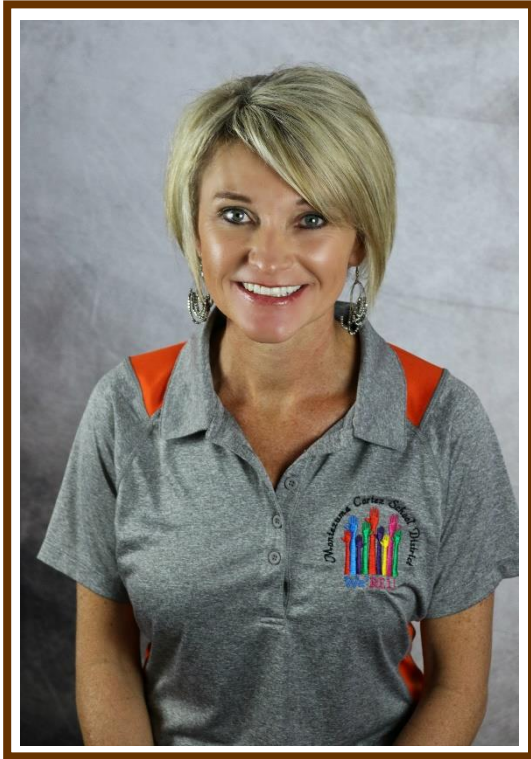


Kara Suckla – Board Secretary
