# Why do we participate in the teacher of the year program?

New London Public Schools wishes to recognize excellence in teaching and acknowledge the importance of the teaching profession within our community.

# Who is eligible?

Full-time certified pre-k through 12 teachers, including those certified in special subjects, fields or instructional areas who are currently employed by the New London Public Schools. Nominees may not have been a Teacher-of-the-Year within the past ten years. Nominees must have at least three years of experience of employment in New London Public Schools to be eligible for nomination.

# Selection Criteria

- Nominees must receive a minimum of three separate nominations to be considered for the award.
- Nominees receiving three nominations must submit a current resume which demonstrates accomplishments in the categories of professional experience, professional development, extracurricular/community involvement, instructional strategies that promote student achievement, character traits that create an interactive and engaging learning environment, and;
- ➤ Two letters of recommendation.

### Who may nominate a teacher?

Any New London staff member, New London parent, student or New London community member may nominate a "Teacher of the Year". Nomination forms can be found in any of the schools main office, central office or our website, <u>www.newlondon.org</u>.
