Connecticut General Statutes § 17a-101, as amended by Public Acts 02-138 and 11-93, requires certain school employees who have reasonable cause to suspect or believe that a child has been abused, neglected, or placed in imminent risk of serious harm to report these suspicions in compliance with applicable state statutes. The following school employees are considered mandated reporters:

"A teacher, substitute teacher, school administrator, school superintendent, guidance counselor, psychologist, social worker, nurse, physician, school paraprofessional or coach employed by a local or regional board of education or a private elementary, middle or high school or working in a public or private elementary, middle or high school; or (B) any other person who, in the performance of his or her duties, has regular contact with students and who provides services to or on behalf of students enrolled in (i) a public elementary, middle or high school, pursuant to a contract with the local or regional board of education, or (ii) a private elementary, middle or high school, pursuant to a contract with the supervisory agent of such private school."

The district is also required to verify that anyone working or volunteering in the New Milford Schools have received Connecticut DCF mandated reporter training for the reporting of suspected child abuse and neglect. Training is in video format. You may view the video by going to <a href="https://portal.ct.gov/DCF/Mandated-Reporter-Training/Home">https://portal.ct.gov/DCF/Mandated-Reporter-Training/Home</a>. Click on "for school employees". Volunteers will select "All other Mandated Reporters".

You will be asked to register before you watch the video. The video is approximately 30-45 minutes in length.
