Home School & Charter School Participation in Interscholastic Activities Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Does this change begin with the 2012-13 school year? Yes
- 2. How should a home school or charter school student inform the school of his/her intent to participate? Forms are available at all district high schools and are also available online at www.newberry.k12.sc.us.
- 3. How does a school verify grades/eligibility of home school/charter school students? The student is responsible for presenting a record of grades, previous home school/charter school experience on letterhead of the home school association/charter school. It must be signed by the records official of that organization.
- 4. What about other requirements, such as physicals, etc.? The home school/charter school student will need to present the same required paperwork as the "traditional" student.
- 5. May fees be charged to the home school/charter school student? The home school/charter school student may only be charged fees if the "traditional" students are charged the same fee.
- 6. May a home school/charter school student select any school in a district to contact for participation? No. The student may only elect to participate in the school they are zoned by residence.
