He stated the numbers of education students were low. He stated that there did seem to be a good number of special education applicants. He said most recruiters had better set-ups than our District. Another district utilized a laptop and stand to sign-up candidates. The District display was not used.

District Recruitment Fair

Mrs. Arrington reported that the Fair had approximately 50 in attendance. She said the quality of the applicants was very good. She reported they signed a contract with one special education candidate.

CERRA SC Annual Educator Supply and Demand

Ms. Arrington reported from the 2017-2018 report. She stated there has been a 25% reduction in completers of an Education program. She reported that 6,705 teachers left the profession as opposed to 1,684 completers of a program.
