PERTAINING TO THE CIVIL PLANS & SPECIFICATIONS

Item No.	Description
1.	See attached prebid sign in sheet for the mandatory pre-bid meeting.
2.	Contractor will be available to work as required to complete the job prior to August 9 th – there will be no work hour restrictions.
3.	The Contractor will be allowed to cure the Task 1 Cement Modified Base by applying an asphalt membrane immediately following base operations in accordance with SCDOT Spec section 301.4.8.
4.	Clarification on work scope at Newberry High School – Contractor is to remove the existing concrete wheelstops (total of 36), dispose, and install with 36 new wheelstops following paving operations.
5.	Clarification on work scope at Newberry Middle School – see attached sketch SK-C1 for additional asphalt parking areas to be included in both Task 1 and Task 2 as light duty pavement areas.
6.	Clarification on work scope for Task 1 – Contractor is to mill existing asphalt adjacent to existing concrete curb and gutter as required to provide smooth transition from asphalt surface to concrete gutter. Milling of entire existing asphalt will not be required, however contractor to include grading and shaping to meet the above desired finish and provide positive drainage.
7.	Contractor is to base their Task 1 bid on the following cement application rates: Light Duty Pavements - Cement Modified Base to receive 38 lbs/sy cement Heavy Duty Pavements - Cement Modified Base to receive 62 lbs/sy cement
8.	A field mix design process is presently underway and the cement application will be adjusted as required based upon the unit price given in the revised bid form. See attached a revised bid form to include the unit prices and contingency quantities for the following: 18" concrete curb and gutter, cement.

BID Questions/Clarifications:

Q: Please clarify that Task two (2) is the complete removal of the existing asphalt and stone/earth base course and reconstruct with 100% new asphalt and stone. The existing stone base can not be reused.

A: Correct, Task 2 is to include removal and disposal of existing materials and replacement with new material.

Q: Will the School District will responsible if any existing utilities in the parking lot are encountered due to shallow bury depths.

A: The School District will be responsible and respond if any utilities are encountered within working depths noted.

Q: Does the District want to see separate Task pricing for each school?

A: The Lump Sum bid requested is for Task 1 complete for both schools and Task 2 complete for both schools.


