Notice Regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Noli School Parents/Guardians,

The health, wellbeing, and safety of all Noli School students and personnel remain the primary focus as we do everything possible to protect our school during a potential outbreak. Noli School will continue to monitor the spread of the Virus and will stay in constant contact with Riverside County Public Health to stay updated on their recommendations.

According to the Riverside University Health System- Public Health, there are 6 confirmed cases in Riverside County. We recognize this may cause concern among our families and we will do our best to address your concerns. Recently several California school districts and universities have announced that they will be shutting down or suspending classes due to the Coronavirus outbreak. At this time, Noli School will remain in session and take the following precautions:

- Diligent cleaning of the school and all buses.
- Limiting all sporting events to Riverside County only.
- Postponing all off reservation field trips until April 1st.
- Canceling our Career Day on March 27th.

Please understand that we are doing this with an abundance of caution, and that our top priority is the health and safety of our students. It is flu season and we are following the best prevention practices possible. You can also follow by doing the following:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water.
- Keep all surfaces clean.
- Sneeze or cough into your elbow or a tissue.
- Please keep your child home when they are sick with flu-like systems, including a fever of 100 degrees or higher, shortness of breath, and coughing.
