## Inspirational Troupe

Mr. Dooley read a letter from Jonathan Garvin (Inspirational Troupe), asking the Committee to waive the troupe from a building use fee for the remainder of the year. After discussion, the committee agreed to waive 1 month's fee until further information on building use for both schools is presented to the Committee at the next meeting.

# **PARCC**

Mr. Dooley read a letter from the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. The letter states that Norfolk Public Schools does not legally have the right to ask parents if they would like to opt out of the PARCC Assessment. Mr. Dooley wrote a letter to the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education stating that the Norfolk Public School's respectfully disagrees with their ruling that parents do not have the legal right to opt out of the PARCC Assessment. All School Committee members signed the letter.

#### Donation to Fisher House

## Retirement from School Committee
