Donations

MOTION: Mr. Dooley made a motion to accept the donations of \$1741.44 Mr. Peterson, second. All in favor. **The motion passed.**

School Gift Fund Expenditures

Mr. Dooley reviewed the School Gift Fund expenditures totaling \$3,125.56.

SCHOOL COMMITTEE CHAIR REPORT

Superindendent Announcement

Mr. Dooley announced that an offer has been extended to Dr. Ingrid Allardi for Superintendent of Schools to start July 1. The School Committee will negotiate the contract with her this week. She is visiting the schools on April 24th.

HOD Playground Update

Mr. Dooley discussed the addition of playground space at Kunde playground. The Conservation Commission voted against using more space from the Kunde Forest. The DPW is working on scenarios of cost for moving the playground. Lisa Cannon will continue to fundraise for the playground.

Additional Revenue to School From Town of Norfolk

Mr. Dooley worked with Jack Hathaway and the Board of Selectman to create adjustments to the FY2013 budget and add approximately \$75,000 to the school budget. The town will consolidate all utilities. The Town will pay up to \$200,000 for the utilities.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

FY2012 3rd Quarter Report

Todd Hassett, Business Consultant gave the FY2012 3rd Quarter Report. He reported that the Bus Transportation Bid opening is May 14, 2013.

Curriculum Coordinators Report

Kelly Whitmore, Assistant Principal Freeman-Centennial and Debbie Dressler, Assistant Principal, H. Olive Day School gave a presentation on the Math, Science, ELA and Social Studies curriculum. They thanked the teachers working on the committees for their hard work and dedication to this project. They explained how the curriculum is designed by using a process called: Understanding by Design. The Social Studies curriculum will be implemented next year.

The Math Committee has adopted a new math program called: Go Math! This math curriculum was designed to meet the requirement of the Common Core. It is in the second year of publication. There is an initiative in the district for Math Fluency. The students are involved in a free program to use at school and home to increase math fact fluency.

Bullying Report

There has been one bullying incident this year. It was dealt with by the Administration and reported to the DESE.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

School Building Committee:

The project continues to be on budget and a little ahead of schedule. The demolition of the Freeman-Centennial School must be confirmed. The Grand Opening will be planned for a weekend in August. The furniture demos did not come in as planned.

Budget Subcommittee:

Mr. Dooley thanked Jack Hathaway and the Norfolk Selectman for working out a cost saving idea for the schools. Mr. Dooley read a letter from Jack Hathaway. Mr. Hassett agreed that pooling the energy together gives the most benefit. A memorandum of agreement between two boards will be signed. Additional cost savings: the Town will to pay 50% of Technology Director and share custodial staff. This will save \$20,000.

The Committee all agrees to move forward to negotiate a memorandum of agreement with the Board of Selectman.

Mr. Doyle gave an overview of the budget process to date. The Budget Subcommittee will meet after the next meeting on May 2, 2012.
