Dr. Allardi shared with the Sub-Committee the Superintendent Evaluation form that was developed and published by the Mass Dept. of Education.

Dr. Allardi recommended that the Committee set focus areas for her evaluation within each of the rubric standards. The Committee would have the right to include any other areas of concern in the narrative comments of the evaluation. Further discussion of this topic will take place at the next meeting.
