Welcome to Normandy

The Normandy School District was founded in 1894. It is located in St. Louis County, directly northwest of St. Louis City. The district encompasses unincorporated areas of St. Louis County and 24 municipalities.

The Normandy School District enrolls over 5,100 students in preschool through grade 12.

All professional staff members are fully certified by the Missouri Department of Education. Every school has a full-time, non-teaching principal. The average length of tenure for teachers in the district is 16 years.

Students in the district benefit from a strong and aggressive curriculum, a full-range of extracurricular activities, a highly educated and motivated teaching force, low pupil/teacher ratios, and teams of specially trained counselors and social workers -- all committed to enhancing each student's academic and personal growth.
