The Program

Students will acquire the necessary strategies to be confident and successful based on their grade level expectations in both language arts and mathematics in a relaxing and fun environment. Students will receive instruction based on grade level expectations per the Common Core State Standards in both language arts and mathematics. Emphasis will be placed upon areas of specific need for individual students.

A team teaching approach will be used to foster student growth through differentiated instruction. Students will work in flexible groups, as well as in cooperative learning groups. The students will also participate in learning centers and small group activities based on individualized needs.

Course Description for Language Arts: This team taught course is designed to foster the student's love of reading and the attainment of reading and writing skills necessary for success at the next grade level. After initial assessments students will read and creatively write according to their interests in a supportive and nurturing environment.

Course Description for Math: This team taught course is designed to foster attainment of basic math skills necessary for success at the next grade level including strengthening number sense to successfully master the common core state standards. It will also foster the students' love of math through interesting activities which reinforce and further develop math skills mastery.
