Many of our students live in rural areas and have limited access to the internet, which currently prevents online instruction to all students. Therefore, we will meet student needs through paper packets as well as online opportunities. Due to this and the virus, we will not be grading or collecting any of these materials at this time.

Online packets and paper printed packets, consisting of three weeks of remedial work will be available electronically or for pickup at your school from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Monday, March 30th. The paper packets will be available for pickup in front of the school. Parents may request work electronically if they do not wish to pick up paper packets.

Teachers may periodically be in contact over the next few weeks and will be available through email Monday-Friday 9:00 to 2:00. They should respond to any emails by the end of the following workday. Special Education teachers will be contacting parents to discuss student needs and provide additional resources and/or support.
