



North Tippah School District is developing a comprehensive plan for returning to school for the 2020-21 school year. District Administrators have and will continue to monitor information from local, state, and federal sources to be prepared to start this school year. The North Tippah Return to School Comprehensive Plan will be released on **July 15th** to allow for possible updated information over the next week.

**Return to School Plan will include the following:**

**A. Academic Guidance - 2 Options for Instruction:**

1. In-person - Traditional

- the district will provide 2 masks per student to start the year. These will be required on the bus and greatly encouraged during all moments of transition or times of lack of social distancing.

2. Hybrid/Blended - Distance Learning

- Predominantly learning from home, but will require physical attendance for designated assessments, screeners, and for needed additional support.
