

### Addendum 3

1. We are requesting an onsite visit to Tonopah Elementary/Middle School to determine whether there are existing conduit runs that can be used, or whether free cable runs can be used above suspended ceilings between IDF's and/or to classrooms. Are free cable runs acceptable?
