NOTE: Whenever the State Board of Health or local Board of Health determines that there is a dangerous contagious disease in a public school attended by a child for whom exemption from immunization is claimed, the Board of Trustees of the school District or governing body of the charter school in which the child is enrolled shall require either (a) that the child be immunized; or (2) that he remain outside the school environment and the local health officer be notified [NRS 392.446]. Any parent or guardian who refuses to remove his child from the public school in which he is enrolled when retention in school is prohibited under the provisions of NRS 392.435, 392.443 or 392.446 is guilty of a misdemeanor [NRS 392.448].
