

Nye County School District (NCSD) ARL Program Candidate Eligibility Requirements:

Must be willing to commit to a 3 year teaching contract/educational program through Nye County School District (NCSD) and Great Basin College (GBC) or University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV), and

Must apply for an ARL eligible teaching position (Elementary, Secondary, Early Childhood Education or Special Education) via AppliTrack at www.applitrack.com/nye/onlineapp, and

Must be selected for hire in an ARL eligible teaching position, and

Must hold a Bachelor's Degree from a regionally accredited postsecondary institution, and

Must pass the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators competency exams (waived with Master's degree or higher), and

Pass the Praxis II Subject Area Assessment in their specific subject (Middle & High School Assignments only)

Once a candidate is found eligible/recommended for hire, they will need to choose an approved educational provider to begin an ARL Program. The educational provider will supply the candidate with a course schedule to cover ARL Plan requirements and an ARL Tracking Plan will be created and strictly monitored. Candidates must register to take and pass necessary Praxis exams and apply for ARL License through the NVDOE within 30 days of hire (A copy of the ARL Tracking Plan must be included with the license application). ARL Programs can be finished in two (2) years if followed correctly and must be finished within a maximum of three (3) years.

Elementary ARL Plans require the following:

Completion of twenty-seven (27) elementary course credits, **and**Pass the Praxis Elementary Education: Instructional Practice and Applications Exam
*Pass the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades 7-12 Exam (if Middle School assignment)

Secondary ARL Plans require the following:

Completion of eighteen (18) secondary course credits, **and**Pass the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades 7-12 Exam

Early Childhood Education ARL Plans require the following:

Completion of thirty-six (36) early childhood education course credits, **and**Pass the Praxis Early Childhood Education Exam, **and**Pass the Praxis Education of Young Children Exam

Special Education ARL Plans require the following:

Completion of thirty (30) special education course credits, **and**Pass the Praxis Special Education: Core Knowledge and Applications Exam, **and**Pass the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades K-6 Exam, **and**Pass the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching: Grades 7-12 Exam
