## Tips for a Successful Remote Learning Experience

<u>Reduce Distractions</u>: In order to keep your child focused, remove any items that may distract him/her from their coursework such as tablets, cell phones, access to social media, etc.

Be Flexible: Create a schedule that works for you and your child.

<u>Reach out to your child's teacher</u>: Please let your child's teacher know if you are having difficulty, unable to attend/complete classwork, need resources, etc. Keeping the lines of communication is key!


