Requirements/Pre-requisites

- * All Pre AP and Advanced Placement classes require a recommendation from your previous teacher in that content area.
- * All Pre AP classes have summer projects that must be completed at a certain standard and submitted by midnight on July 15th.
- * All Advanced Placement classes require you to sign a contract that outlines your responsibilities.

Summer Projects

- * You will receive your summer project tonight. If you have questions, feel free to contact the instructor by school email.
- * Projects must be submitted through school email to the instructor and to the counselor, Zonia Rodriguez.
- * Some instructors will want you to turn in the hard copy of your project on the first day of school.

Advance Placement Contract

- * Signed by both the student and the parent
- * You must commit to take the AP Exam in the spring
- * Reimbursement is available based on passing scores
- * Cost for exams is \$84.00

Which Route to Earn College Credit

Advanced Placement

- * Rigorous Syllabus
- * Taught by high school instructor
- * Designed to challenge students
- * Extensive Content Covered
- * Requires passing score on exam based on college selected
- * Weighted average

Dual Credit

- * College level curriculum
- * Taught by college instructor
- * Online and face-to-face
- * Requires discipline to complete
- * Non-traditional school day
- * College Credit if course passed
- * Weighted average
