During this time of uncertainty, Odem-Edroy ISD recognizes the challenges and concerns parents and guardians are facing regarding education, health and the safety of their children. San Patricio County continues to experience an increased number of COVID-19 cases. To help with your decision making, Odem-Edroy ISD is planning for a start to the 2020-21 school year on August 19, 2020 with all students via online instruction through September 8th.

For the Fall of 2020, Odem-Edroy ISD will provide families two methods of instructional delivery.

Option One: In-Person: Face-to-Face (F2F) Instruction:

This option follows the traditional school model where students participate in daily, 100% face-to-face instruction. Instruction will follow the Odem-Edroy ISD scope and sequence. Campuses will strictly adhere to health guidance regarding prevention, response, and mitigating practices.

Option Two: Virtual Instruction:

This option requires daily participation, 100% virtual learning. Instruction follows the Odem-Edroy ISD scope and sequence. The level of rigor, workload, time commitment, and scheduling of classes will be the key difference between what students experienced in the Spring of 2020 and what will be expected in the Fall of 2020.

Regardless of the choice you make, students will be required to participate and have daily attendance. We will prioritize health above all things through enhanced health and safety protocols.
