PARKING LOT SAFETY REMINDERS



Morning Drop-Off:

- In the drop-off lane, always pull completely forward to allow several students to be dropped off at once. This will allow cars to flow through without causing a large backup or stop in traffic.
- If you wish to get out of your car to walk your child to the building, please park your car in the designated visitor parking area *only*.
- For additional safety measures, please make sure students are exiting the vehicle from the passenger side only (right side of the vehicle).

Afternoon Pick-Up:

- There will be two pick-up lanes each afternoon in order to prevent a large backup of cars. Please pull completely forward in the pickup lanes until your child is walked out to your car.
- If you wish to get out of your car to wait for your child outside the building, please park your car in the designated visitor parking area only.

Always use the crosswalk when walking to and from the building.

New and familiar faces!

This year Odem Elementary has two Reading Interventionists for the Pre-K and Kindergarten classes. They are Mrs. Jena Hunter, and Mrs. Dora J. Sturgeon. Mrs. Hunter has been a part of the OES family as a Second grade teacher, and Mrs. Sturgeon is new to OEISD. They work with small groups within each classroom, developing Reading Readiness skills. Reading Readiness skills include letter identification, oral language and phonological awareness. Letter identification works on identifying the letters, and letter sounds. Oral language works on identifying and developing daily and functional language, using themes such as community helpers. Phonological awareness works on connecting sounds, such as rhyming and developing the spoken language. The Reading Interventionists provide support for the teachers by using multisensory activities that will develop proficiency skills in each of these areas.
