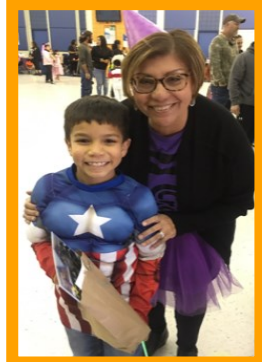

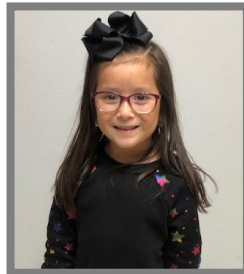
PreK:

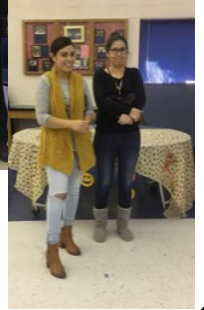
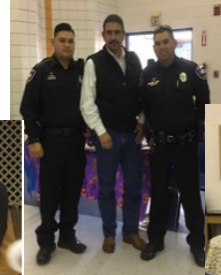
