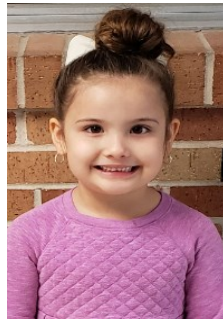


## STUDENT SPOLIGHT

Lily is always attentive and ready to learn. Her smile, kindness, and willingness to help her friends and teachers brightens our class!



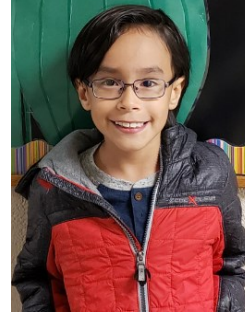
Dezlyn Gomez

2nd Grade

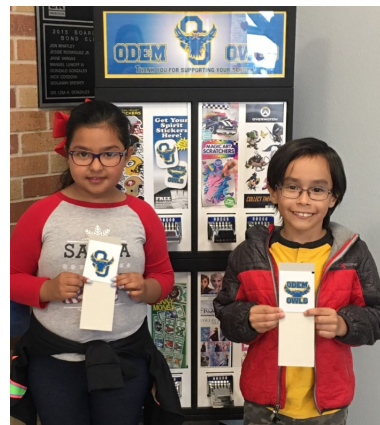
Mateo is a great example of a positive student. He always comes to class well prepared and ready to learn. You will never find him without his great attitude.

## When is the last day of school for students?

Students that meet the following criteria will NOT be required to attend the final seven days of school from May 20-28, 2020. The last day of school for students who meet this requirement will be Tuesday May 19th.

- 90% Attendance rate for the school year (no more than 17 absences)
- Have a 70 or higher yearly average in reading/language arts for the school year
- Have a 70 or higher yearly average in math for the school year
- Kindergarten TPRI– Developed on Screener and Letter Names & Sounds
