

## Oneida High School Parent Involvement Plan

1. Oneida High School will conduct an annual meeting each school year to discuss the expectations for parent involvement and Title I requirements. The plan will be developed with parental input and distributed to parents via the parent announcements via email, in the school handbook, and on the system website.
2. Oneida High School will involve parents in the planning, review and improvement of programs concerning school level parent involvement and the school wide plan (TSIP).
3. The school will discuss and distribute the school-parent-student compact that outlines how parents, school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement.
4. Oneida High School will describe the school curriculum, the forms of assessments, and how these assessments measure student proficiency levels. Assessment results will be provided to parents with explanations of how to understand scores and levels.
5. The school will provide parents mid-term progress and report cards on a regular basis. We also will provide course descriptions, freshmen information, four-year plans, and test score reports; as needed. Skyward and school email will be used to provide electronic information to parents.
6. The school will address the importance of communication between the teachers and parents on an ongoing basis. Parent-teacher conferences will be held once each semester and/or be conducted at parent request. Frequent progress reports will be issued and parents will have access to staff. Parents may also access grades, discipline, and attendance via Skyward.
7. The school will build parents' capacity for involvement by helping them understand topics related to academic content standards, student academic achievement standards and how to monitor a child's progress, and work with educators to improve the achievement of their children.

8. The school will educate teachers and assistants in the value and utility of parents' contributions, and in how to communicate and work with parents as partners in order to build ties between parents and the school.
9. The school will have parent involvement activities with the Family Resource Center including parenting classes, parent-teacher conferences, Art and Drama Performance, Athletic Events, Scholar-Bowl events, Career Fair, Senior Night events, and Senior Scholarship Night.
10. The school will encourage all parents to participate in school-related organizations; including sports and band booster clubs, foreign travels clubs, informational meetings regarding financial aid and four-year plans; to serve on committees and to be involved in other school activities conducted by the school.
11. The school will provide materials and training to help parents work with their children to improve their children's achievement, such as literacy training and using technology.
12. Whenever appropriate, information about school events, meetings student reports and other activities will be sent to parents in an understand language. All parents, including those with limited English proficiency, disabilities and parents of migratory children, will have full opportunity to participate in school program.
13. Upon the request of parents, the school will set up meetings for parents to give suggestions and be part of the decision making related to their child's education, and the school will respond to the suggestions as soon as possible.
14. The school will provide other reasonable support for parental involvement activities as parents may request.
