The Oneida Special School District Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, April 3, 2014, at 6:00 p.m. in the Oneida High School Library. The following members were present: Dr. Danny Cross, Mr. Tommy Bell, Mrs. Dorothy Watson, Mr. Mark Matthews and Dr. Nancy Williamson. Also in attendance were Director Ann Sexton, Student Representative Gavin Webb and Board Secretary Lori Marcum.

Chairperson Williamson called the meeting to order. Baleigh Smith led those in attendance in the pledge of allegiance.

Chairperson Williamson recognized Director Sexton for student recognitions. Chairperson Williamson presented the board agenda for consideration with three (3) additions. Mrs. Watson made a motion, with a second by Dr. Cross, to approve the board agenda as amended. Vote was taken and motion carried.

Mrs. Watson made a motion, with a second by Dr. Cross, to approve the leave as presented. Vote was taken and motion carried.

Chairperson Williamson then presented a request for the Imagination Library Sponsorship. Mrs. Watson made a motion, with a second by Mr. Bell, to sponsor the Imagination Library Program for the month of June. Vote was taken and motion carried.

Chairperson Williamson then presented the Custodial Service Contract for board consideration. After a brief discussion, it was noted that contracting with GCA for custodial services would save the district approximately \$11,000. The contract would be for one (1) year, with the option to extend if both parties agree. Dr. Cross made a motion, with a second by Mr. Bell, to approve the custodial contract with GCA.
