- Consistency and movement to better safe and civil campus

Anticipated Outcomes of 2012-2015 (Hunters Creek Middle) Strategic Plan

As a community school, HCMS will increase student proficiency in Math, Reading, and Science in all grade levels and across all subgroups. We will work to increase Tier 2 classrooms, as well as 1:1 technology programs with our students. We must also continue to meet the demands of using technology as an instructional tool, while demonstrating to our students the importance and power of being a “good digital citizen”. Within parameters of Federal regulation and funding we will continue to work to better serve our EC population and restructure as needed; therefore, we need to create an inclusive environment in all classes. HCMS will work to develop an environment in which all students are being provided an opportunity to grow and receive strategies to ensure academic success, as well as become socially aware of their behaviors and responsible citizens of the WO community. We will implement programs such as SAVE and other mentoring groups to target at-risk students and help them become socially responsible and decrease bullying across the campus. HCMS will be the bridge for the STEM students, and emerging leaders that our feeder elementary schools provide to become the college and career readiness students that our High school feeder desires.
