**Goal 1:**

- Increased Math % Career/College Ready (CCR) ( $\approx$  2%, unofficial)
- Increased Math 1, Math 2 participation ( $\approx$  20%)
- Increased 6<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA Grade Level Proficiency (GLP) ( $\approx$  2%, unofficial)
- Completed EC schedule/staffing reorganization for more effective service delivery
- Completed Rigor/Relevance initiative with English 1, Math 2 and Earth/Env. Science

**Goal 2:**

- Increased % of 1:1 classrooms (66% increase)
- Increased % of Teachers with Advanced Degrees ( $\approx$  10%)
- Maintained 100% Tier 2 classrooms
- Completed Positive School Culture initiative (mentoring, NBPTS support, staff recognition)
- Implemented Digital Communication Plan (Facebook, Twitter, website, Messenger)

**Goal 3:**

- Increased STEM touches by  $\approx$  15% (robotics, Samsung, NASA, Science Bowl)
- Increased positive student/staff perception of "respect" ( $\approx$  3%)
- Maintained 5 Star Safe School Plan rating
- Promoted student safety and responsibility (Red Ribbon, DARE, GREAT, SOM program)
- Completed advocacy survey for all students

**Goal 4:**

- Increased web traffic/utilization by stakeholders ( $\approx$  15%)
- Increased community engagement through specific events (7 events for 2014-15)
- Increased parent/community volunteers (233 to 250)
- Maintained NBMS partnerships (NCSU Science House, UNCW, ECU, Sturgeon City)
- Maintained 3-week progress reporting

**Goal 5:**

- 3% increase in recycling effort through Project Green Bear
- Monitored monthly energy consumption
- Continued energy efficient window replacement plan
- Implemented electronic processing tools (work orders, check-ins, automated calls)
- Increased utilization of USATestPrep for benchmarking
