School's Strengths:

- Project Based Learning Site
- 86% or more of the students who are serviced at OCLC successfully completed their academic requirements and or goals
- Student reward field trips explore different cultures, colleges, museums and careers
- 83% of the educational staff have multiple certifications
- Class sizes are considerably smaller than a traditional setting which allows more one-on-one instruction
- Increased Community Involvement
- Teachers have multiple certifications
- Farm animals are maintained and cared for by students

School's Challenges:

- Limited budget
- High truancy rate among high school students
- Over 48% of students are diagnosed with severe mental illness
- 30% of student population is EC
- Additional bus drivers needed
- Do not have full access to Power Schools
- Limited building occupancy space

2013-2014 Focused Next Actions:

- Conduct targeted and meaningful training and staff development
- Gain full access to Power Schools
- Maintain 100% of current and up-to-date Personalized Education Plans (PEP's)
- Continue Rewards/Enrichment Field Trips
- Decrease high school truancy rate
- Continue to expand in the area of community involvement
