Final Strategic Action Plan Results For 2009-2010

OCLC Goal #1: Students will be globally competitive through the mastery of a rigorous and relevant curriculum:

- Students performed a school wide writing initiative weekly on global topics
- Weekly training sessions were conducted by the IT facilitator to train teachers in advanced instructional technology practices
- Staff Development was provided for: *Framework for Understanding Poverty* and weekly lesson plans were developed and submitted to support implementation throughout the school year

OCLC Goal #2: Students will be led by creative, passionate and technologically skilled professionals:

- Weekly staff development was conducted by the OCS IT department on use of technology within the educational setting
- Initial introduction training and quarterly reviews on the regulations, procedures, and strategies for developing and maintaining a Personal Educational Plan (PEP) were performed
- Teacher Individual Growth Plans (IGP) focused on improved knowledge and skills related to : technology, interconnectedness of world and global awareness, and mandate state PEP requirements
- Teachers received one credit hour training on the new North Carolina Teacher Evaluation Process
- ICE/Static Stop Out Program was used, resulting in a noticeable reduction in student discipline referrals
- Advisory Advisee (AA) period focused on: Team Building, Character Education, Study Skills, Dropout Prevention, Financial Management, Positive Behavior Intervention, and Global awareness
- The security system was updated and expanded
- The Crisis Plan was updated and maintained
- Safe and Civil Schools components were in place and ongoing throughout the school year

OCLC Goal #4: Leadership will foster innovation with the cooperation of families and community partners:

- Continued implementation of Strategic Plan goals took place
- There was full stakeholder participation during Intake Meetings
- Exit transitions were conducted

OCLC Goal #5: OCLC will be supported by effective and efficient systems:

- There was continued use of “Responsibility Chart”
- There was student, staff, and parent participated in the OCS climate survey
- The “Triple S” notebook was maintained
- School wide usage of Outlook for inner faculty and staff communication and scheduling was utilized the entire school year
