School Vision: Together We All Succeed

School Mission: PWE will partner with communities to build unique learners with endless possibilities

School Purpose: To nurture and educate children

Goal 1:

- Unofficial preliminary results indicate that our proficiency on state assessments are as follows: CCR – 44% and GLP – 54%
- Employed part-time tutors – 3 – 5 Math and 4 – 5 Reading
- Implemented use of Data Notebooks K - 5
- K – 2 results in Math: K – 89%, 1st – 81%, 2nd – 94%
- Held monthly AVID site team meetings (Grades 4 and 5)

Goal 2:

- Teachers and Instructional Assistants participated in Teaching Children from Poverty workshop
- All staff members participated in Habits of Mind training
- Provided opportunities for technology training
- Select teachers participated in Singapore Math and PBL training
- All licensed staff completed Modules 1 – 4 (First year) of VIF Training

Goal 3:

- Revised Kiss and Drive procedures
- Provided Digital Citizenship Training to students K - 5
- Revised Crisis Plan/Procedures and conducted a Lock-down Drill
- ASSIST Survey data reveals that 97% of parents, staff and students feel our school is safe (up from 86%)
- Girls on the Run and Stride offered to students grades 3 - 5

Goal 4:

- Participated in Jacksonville District Initiatives (to include Homecoming Parade and Art Show)
- Conducted Volunteer Training during Open House and on as needed basis throughout the year
- Completed BASES report
- Established new community partnerships (i.e. Lowe's Foods)
- Established committees to address Strategic Goal implementation/monitoring

Goal 5:

- Established a Buddy-to-Buddy Program utilizing 4th and 5th grade students
- Established and continuously updated a Parkwood Elementary Facebook page
- A school level team participated in Digital Army Training
- Used the Digital Platform to include USA TestPrep, Edmodo and Onslow View
- Expanded use of digital newsletters from the school level to classroom level

Overall Successes

Completed staff-wide training in Habits of Mind and presented theme concept to the Board of Education in May 2015

Reduced percentage difference between CCR and GLP by 2%

Increased reports of safe environment perception from 86% to 97%

Completed VIF Year 1 training

Increased K -2 Math proficiency from 85% to 88%

Implementation of Habits of Mind (Begin with 5 habits – school-wide)

All licensed staff complete VIF Year 2 training

Continue to reduce gap between CCR and GLP

Focused PD on Math and Literacy Instruction
