School Executive's Message:

Parkwood Elementary increased the number of students who demonstrated proficiency on state assessments from 43.8 % to 44.4% (CCR). Our grade level proficiency on the same assessments was 56.2. We met 28 out of 31 Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs). We were above district averages; however slightly below the state. We did not meet AMOs in Math and met the goal with the CI with EDS and SWD. Parkwood met AMOs in Reading and Science with the CI. ASSIST survey data reveals that 81% of our stakeholders agree that our school has a safe learning environment.

School's Strengths:

 $\overline{K-2 \text{ Math} - 85\%}$ or higher on grade level

3rd Grade Reading – GLP and TRC levels – 70%

ASSIST Survey – Over 95% of students believe that the principal and teachers want every student to learn.

Met all AMOs in Reading

Partnership with Jacksonville District Schools

School's Challenges:

3 – 5 Math – CCR -39.5% GLP – 50%

Overall proficiency differences between CCR and GLP – approximately 12 points $1^{\rm st}$ Grade Reading – 59% proficiency

Student growth – average students did not grow at the same rate as higher/lower achieving students

Focus on Math instruction – hire PT Math tutor – Grades 3 – 5

Hire a part-time Reading tutor Grades 4 and 5

Hire At-Risk Tutor – Grade 2

Enrichment Team Tutoring – Grades 3 - 5
