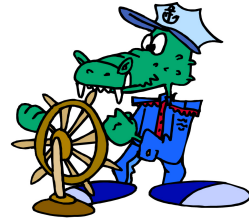

Summary-

Queens Creek Elementary will continue and expand a number of the initiatives begun through the present School Improvement Plan. Our AVID 5th graders will be joined next year by our 4th grade students. Instructionally we will be participating in the Bridges grant and moving forward in CIA development through a planned staff development, supported in our PLC teams. We are currently exploring Quantiles as a teacher instructional resource. Through staff articulation we will continue our efforts in the use of data to target the specific needs of the students. Our staff web pages will continue to expand; linked to the work we will do in CIA planning. The Gator Buddies, Gator Tots and other character education initiatives will continue with the emphasis begun this year on bullying. Our school safety committee will also be active as they work to help our school align our safety procedures as a county system. Parent instructional opportunities will be planned to support students and parents. We will utilize a variety of resources to determine the focus of these gatherings. Communication efforts will also be strategically important as we continue to meet the needs of our school community as a whole.

As a school we are looking forward to transitioning from this Plan to our future efforts. We have worked hard to implement this initiative in a thoughtful professional manner. We look forward to constructing our new Plan with a focus on moving the students of QCE forward into the 21st Century.
