**2013-2014 Focused Next Actions:**

- Conduct a PLC with all Ready EOC areas to disaggregate benchmark data and utilize this information to identify at risk students and areas of mastery.
- Continue to identify students with specific needs for additional tutoring during Pirate Academy.
- Require all teachers to utilize technology in the classroom and conduct an observation of a peer each semester.
- Use many modes of communication with parents to ensure accurate information about graduation requirements, weekly progress, happenings at SHS, and individual student progress. (Weekly parent emails, website updates, staff newsletter weekly, parent report card newsletters, counselor meetings, etc.)
- Increase proficiency in all areas as measured by EOC scores.

**Greatest Accomplishment in 2012-2013:**

Swansboro High School has many areas to be proud of from the data that tells our story. The greatest point that is gleaned is that our change in growth as a school went from -13.3 to -4.7. That is a net difference of +8.6. That is amazing and speaks volumes for the work that is done inside the Swansboro High School walls.
