**Vision:** Swansboro Middle School will be a clean, safe, caring school where students and staff are engaged in learning. Swansboro Middle School will be a school where staff, students, families, and the community work together towards growth and learning. Swansboro Middle School will guide students in order to develop the necessary skills for continuous learning. Swansboro Middle School will be the center of a cohesive & collaborative environment that fosters learning. Swansboro Middle School will build trust and earn respect among staff, students and families and the community to inspire learning.

**Goals: 5 Bullets per goal; 3 data-driven, 2 General we will remove this reminder before publishing)**

#### **Goal 1:**

- 100% of students were proficient in Math 1
- 100% of EOG teachers were trained in EVAAS and built class rosters
- EOG teachers calculated proficiency on EOGs and used student projection report in EVASS to gauge student growth
- Offered Spanish to students and used a VIF teacher for instruction
- Established possible sister school in Finland as the Swansboro district continues to work on Finland partnership

#### **Goal 2:**

- Monthly professional development was provided to the staff by the Digital Learning Facilitator
- 100% of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders used 1:1 laptops in classes on a daily basis
- 100% 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade used Edmodo as the primary communication and learning platform and 100% of 6<sup>th</sup> grade began incorporating Edmodo into lessons
- Students used video conference system (Onslow View) to conduct Mystery Skypes, video conferencing with other schools around county, to read to elementary students on Dr. Seuss' Birthday
- Deployment of 1:1 was relatively seamless and overall very successfully

#### **Goal 3:**

- Monthly meetings of Safe and Civil School team occurred. Team created a new tiered behavioral plan for next school year
- Bus Rider of Week program was implemented. Students selected were rewarded with public recognition and an ice cream sandwich
- Discipline Referrals to the office were down 30%
- Lock down drill was completed with assistance from local law enforcement
- Advisory program was not implemented with fidelity and thus was not successful

**Goal 4:**

- Increased parent participation on the ASSIST Survey to 57%
- Held 6 registration events for the community
- Established an parent outreach program and included community partnerships
- Regiment of Marines has adopted SBMS
- Increased communication from school to parents with bi monthly calls home

**Goal 5:**

- 100% 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders used 1:1 laptops daily
- MTAC meet monthly and created new 1:1 guidelines for next school year; also created needed guidelines as issues occurred during the school year
- 100% of campus is wireless
- 100% of NCFEs and 7<sup>th</sup> grade EOG were completed online
- High school and middle school worked in partnership to register students and prepare for transition to high school

**Overall Successes**

SBMS has shown gains in academic growth and student achievement. The school is 100% wireless and has implemented the 1:1 laptop program. Students and staff are comfortable utilizing technology in the classroom.

**Continued and Necessary Next Steps**

SBMS needs to refocus on data driven instruction. The teams need to embrace PLCs and use data to move the school forward. Teams need to collaborate more through common planning time to best meet the needs of the students. Continue 1:1 implementation in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Allow for an enrichment/intervention period each day to meet the needs of both AIG and at risk students.
