

SRE Goal # 1: Sand Ridge Elementary students will be globally competitive through the mastery of a rigorous and relevant curriculum.

Strategy: Implement a unified, balanced, inquiry-based curriculum in order to prepare students to be globally competitive.

Actions/Tasks Achieved:

- Teachers submitted sample lesson plans centered around a global theme and began integrating global concepts and themes within instructional content, Use of Video Conferencing
- Display of World Map, Cultural Correspondent Program, World View Partner (UNC-Chapel Hill)
- Purchase of Interactive Educational Poster on the Chinese Language
- Assistant Principal attended World View Professional Development on Latin America and East Asia
- All Grade Levels submitted a Bright Ideas Grants; received two grants for 09-10
- Best Practices were shared at two staff meetings a month
- Lesson Plans included the Essential Question
- Staff were provided an overview of the concepts Big Three and Super Six
- AVID is fully implemented in Grade 5 and in one 4th Grade classroom
- Students using AR read an average of 202, 419 words each and took an average of 61 quizzes each (national level for impressive achievement in student reading practice)
- Walk Across America Program, AR Celebration and Incentives
- PLC Staff Development for whole staff; Test Talk to interested participants
- All students receive computer class each week
- Academic Derby Team won at County level
- Inclusion augments instruction to EC students in grades 2-5, AIG Students are clustered
- Tutors used in grades 3-5 for at-risk students
- Common planning for all grade level every day; Weekly meetings held for EC department
- Use of an enrichment/intervention block for all students
- Literacy Facilitator provided consultation and direct instruction schoolwide
- Team of staff (6 individuals) attended Models Schools Conference
- Two field trips per year for each grade level were organized
- Implemented a “**Themed School**” concept (Global Partner) to begin with 10-11 school year

- Continued BT/M Program for all Probationary Teachers
- One staff received National Board Certification, and one renewed her certification
- Five staff members submitted for National Board Certification
- Interested Staff participated in Bridges Training, All certified staff received PEP Training
- Interested and selected staff received CPI Training
- Best Practices presented at two staff meetings per month

- Project Wisdom Concepts and OCS Character Education Traits presented daily via announcements
- 5th Grade students received middle school orientation
- Purchase of all new radios (all grade chairs issued radios)
- Continue use of Common Area Policies
- Township Meeting at the beginning of the year to cover expectations, guidelines for success and common area policies
