



Stateside Elementary School 2009-2010

Patriots, active learners, IMPACTING our World!

OCS Goal 1: Onslow County School Students will be globally competitive through the mastery of a rigorous and relevant curriculum.

Patriot Strategy: Ensure that the diverse needs of all students are met through challenging and differentiated instruction.

- ✓ Student proficiency results on NC EOG tests for grades 3-5 overall performance composite: reading 83.9%, math 86.7% and science at 82.2% proficiency.
- ✓ IMPACT model was implemented to foster effective teaching, learning, and planning.
- ✓ *WAVE* scheduling was implemented in order to increase uninterrupted instructional time as well as provide uninterrupted teacher collaboration time.
- ✓ Two teachers formally trained at AVID Summer Institute. AVID methodologies implemented in all fifth grade classrooms.
- ✓ Initial planning, Curriculum Mapping, Big Idea 6/Super 3 staff development was provided on June 23rd, June 30th, July 13th and 14th. These strategies were utilized across grade levels and reinforced at Monday Morning Meetings.
- ✓ A leveled book room was established. School-wide training on its use was provided by Scholastic.
- ✓ Student ambassadors were selected and trained. These students helped at Stateside's dedication, Open House, *Books on Bases*, NEHS induction and other special events. Stateside received the first National Elementary Honor Society Charter in Onslow County on November 16, 2009.
- ✓ Chess materials were purchased to foster AIG enrichment.
- ✓ Two other special enrichment classes implemented on the WAVE rotation, Cultural Awareness and Guidance.
- ✓ Scholastic *Investigations*, a science curriculum, piloted.
- ✓ *Renaissance Place* and *First in Math* computer based programs were implemented and available for both at home and school use. A *First in Math* link is available on our school website.
- ✓ *Number Worlds* implemented in the resource EC setting and *Touch Math* implemented in one autistic class.
- ✓ An Instructional Intervention Team was formed. Of the concerns brought to the team, eighteen students were presented for testing and 16 of those students qualified for EC services.
- ✓ *EnVisions* and *Investigations* Joint Usage Math program was purchased/implemented school-wide and representatives participated in *EnVisions* professional development follow up on January 22, 2010.
- ✓ K-5 student centered activities developed by the Florida Center for Reading Research staff development held on January 11, 2010 with fifteen staff members attending.

OCS Goal 2: Onslow County Schools and students will be led by creative, passionate and technologically skilled professionals.

Patriot Strategy: Create a school climate that nurtures creativity, passion, and innovation while promoting and strengthening technological competencies.

- ✓ Fourth and fifth grade teachers participated in EVAAS training in the fall. Additionally all staff was trained during team meetings on interpreting EOG Individual Student Report Summary sheets in the spring.
- ✓ The staff participated in New Teacher Eval training and a focus was placed on teacher leadership. Action teams were created at the end of the school year to increase leadership roles and buy-in as Stateside enters its 2nd year.
- ✓ The Richlands Denmark partnership continued with shared emails and letters.
- ✓ Stateside teachers received various grants including, Jones-Onslow, Knights of Columbus, Adopt a Classroom, and Donors Chose.
- ✓ Two teachers continue seeking National Board Certification and four are seeking master's degrees.
- ✓ Administrator participated in District Data Analysis PLC.

OCS Goal 3: Onslow County School students will learn in a safe environment to be civil, healthy, and productive citizens.

Patriot Strategy: Develop and maintain roles, procedures, and responsibilities needed to maintain a safe and orderly learning environment and a healthy/physically fit lifestyle.

- ✓ 10X10X10 thirty minute physical activity daily expectation for all students.
- ✓ OCS district-wide Crisis Management plan implemented.
- ✓ A school-wide token economy system was put into place September 2009 as well as leveled discipline discussed.
- ✓ De-escalation strategies/verbal portion of CPI training was presented at team meetings in the fall.
- ✓ Monday Morning Meetings are an integral part of the driving forces at Stateside. This school-wide forum focuses on teaching and modeling school-wide expectations, values and themes as well as providing a venue for showcasing student talents.
- ✓ Completed Safe Schools Site Audit and met OCS safe schools requirements
- ✓ Service Learning became a driving force at Stateside Elementary with a focus on Pay It Forward. Financial donations were made to Pennies for Peace, Houses for Haiti, Jump Rope for Heart, American Diabetes Foundation, and Relay for Life
- ✓ The updated legislation on Bullying presented to the staff on January 21, 2010.
- ✓ School bus safety encouraged through "Buster the Bus" visit.

OCS Goal 4: Leadership will foster innovation in the Onslow County School System with the cooperation of families and community partners.

Patriot Strategy: Build community support through programs/events that invite involvement with the cooperation of families and community partners.

- ✓ A Parent Board was established with fourteen members serving as liaisons.
- ✓ Parent University Nights were held: National Service night-September 22nd, Literacy-November 19th, Math-March 4th, Student-led conferences-March 17th.
- ✓ *Books on Bases* Event hosted at Stateside.
- ✓ Bobbi Raub, military liaison, presented *Soar* materials and Wanda Broome, Scholastic rep, presented *Reading is Succeeding* on November 19, 2009.
- ✓ Volunteer training provided to members of the Stateside community on March 11, 2010.
- ✓ Participation in community business nights to include: Ci Ci's Pizza, Chik-fil-A, Wendy's, Heavenly Brew, Barnes and Nobles, and Piggly Wiggly.
- ✓ Electronic communication was established and maintained through Stateside's webpage, Twitter, and AlertNow.
- ✓ Rolling Thunder, Jacksonville Chapter, presented information in the spring at a parent night. Half Moon Fire department presented on several occasions.
- ✓ School level partnership efforts within the district

OCS Goal 5: Onslow County Schools will be supported by effective and efficient systems.

Patriot Strategy: Promote the instructional and operational efficiency of the school by providing resources and effectively utilizing the skills and talents of all support staff.

- ✓ All staff participated in PLCs.
- ✓ Regular Beginning Teacher meetings held to include guest speakers.
- ✓ Initial Safe and Civil strategies discussed and implemented.
- ✓ An effort made to increase technology, 90% of all classrooms have a Promethean, smart board or mimio.
- ✓ Created student ID badges with NCWISE identification numbers to support the cafeteria and media check out processes

As Stateside opened its doors for the first time on August 25th, it was our hope to provide a culture that promoted active learners, service learning, and strong sense of community.
