Final testing results for the 2013-2014 school year indicated that Stateside obtained a 57.7% performance composite (CCR) and 68.8% performance composite (GLP). This composite was the second highest in the county last year and above state averages in all areas. We met all 35 of our state and all 25 of our Federal AMO's. With focused intervention and a culture of high expectations and success, Stateside Elementary was able to achieve a status of High Growth for its students.
