## School Purpose To Inspire Learning

#### **Goal 1:**

- Grow Cohort Graduation rate to 88%. Achieved based on unofficial preliminary results
- % scored 17 or higher on ACT
- 100% of seniors presented their graduation project successfully
- 153 took Workkeys CRC. 44% were proficient to include 1 Platinum, 36 Gold, 30 Bronze. and 86 Silver
- Our Seniors received the following Endorsements: 67 Career, 161 College, 164 UNC University, and 56 Academic Scholars.

### Goal 2:

- 2014-15 ASSIST Survey showed 87% of our staff participate in continuous professional learning based on identified needs of the school
- 88% of our staff in the 2014-15 ASSIST Survey felt our school provides a plan for the acquisition and support of technology to support the school's operational needs
- 2014-15 ASSIST Survey showed 90% of our staff felt there exists a formal structure so that each student is well known by at least one adult advocate in the school who supports that student's educational experience
- 94% highly Qualified Teachers
- 25% TEACHERS WITH advanced degrees and 12 National Board Certified

## **Goal 3:**

- Reportable Crimes where down from 8 to 6
- Decreased our out of school suspension by 16% from 92 to 74
- Implemented and posted Safe and Civil Schools behavior rubrics is hot zones throughout the school
- Created Anti Bullying posters school wide and promoted public service announcements to the school body.

#### Goal 4:

- Cut our drop outs from 23 in 2014 to 14 for 2015
- 100% School Messenger calls done every Sunday evening to families
- ASSIST Survey of parents showed 89% felt administrators and teachers monitor and inform them o students learning progress
- Incorporated classroom walk through for staff to do at least 3 times per semester
- Held College Night, Open House, and Informational Technology nights for parents

#### Goal 5:

- ASSIST SURVEY of parents reflects 89% felt we communicate effectively about the school's goals and activities
- ASSIST SURVEY of staff reflects 88% felt our school has a continuous improvement process based on data, goals, actions and measures for growth.
- ASSIST SURVEY of staff reflects 90% felt our school has a formal structure in place for each student to make sure they are well known by at least one adult advocate who supports their educational experience
- Mentor /Mentee program met monthly and train the trainer techniques were given at each meeting in technology, classroom management and curriculum
- Improved the zones for our custodial staff and their weekly assessment of their areas by developing a monitoring document.

- Implemented a recognition and celebration each6 weeks for our honor/principal list students
- 100% seniors presented senior project
