- 1. Terry Cole called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. James Baker offered invocation.
- 3. Motion James Baker, seconded by Denise Williams to approve the July 7, 2014 Minutes. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 4. Mr. Cox presented the new Generation Ready contract. He stated that the contract is for 60 days at STEM and 40 days at North for a total of \$150,000 to be paid from NSLA funds. Motion Sylvester Belcher, seconded by Denise Williams to approve the Generation Ready contract. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 5. Motion Sylvester Belcher, seconded by Denise Williams to approve the Timed Agenda with the adjusted time of 6:48. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 6. Mr. Cox reviewed the financial report with the board and handed out a financial report of the last two years stating that we have spent some money, we've given raises and bonuses and we probably need to look at buying a new bus and new school van. He stated that we have a 3.6 million dollar carry over and our carry over has increased three years in a row.
- 7. Mr. Cox reviewed the list of bills with the Board. Motion James Baker, seconded by Randy Carney to pay the bills as listed. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
- 8. In the Superintendent's Report Mr. Cox read a letter pertaining to the School & Youth Campaign that STEM and Carroll Smith Elementary participated in for blood cancer awareness. STEM raised \$929.59 and Carroll Smith Elementary raised \$32.00.

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Mr. Cox stated that the only thing left on the Energy Savings Project is the programming. He stated that we will be ready to go when school starts and the bathroom renovations will also be ready when school starts.

Mr. Cox stated that he and Mr. Hogan started a campaign to get new scoreboards for the football field. He stated that they started asking for donations and they get their name on the score board. He stated they raised about \$15,000 in about 20 minutes. He stated that so far we have collected a total of \$21,500 from GCA, Regions, Pepsi, RGB and SIEMES and the cost of the total cost is \$28, 201.31. Mr. Cox stated that the company they will purchase the scoreboards from are out of Missouri and they don't belong to TIP TAP organization so we need to pass a resolution to become a member of the National Purchasing Cooperative so we can get this price. Motion Randy Carney, seconded by James Baker to approve the Resolution. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
