

Policy

TUITION

With the assistance of the Board Secretary/Business Administrator, the Superintendent of Schools shall annually estimate the tuition for each sending district student attending Paulsboro Public Schools.

Students may be admitted as tuition students if:

- A. Their parents apply to the district by letter;
- B. The building principal reviews the letter and finds that the student is in good standing in his originating school and would be a positive influence in the Paulsboro School District;
- C. Is recommended by the superintendent; and
- D. The Paulsboro Board of Education approves.

Tuition for these students would be set annually by the Board of Education. Tuition will be set using the percentage of cost that would be paid locally by Paulsboro residents.

The cost per student for grades Pre-K to 8 would be set at the over-all local cost per student. The cost for a student in grades 9-12 will be at the local rate for that grade level.
