ANNUAL BUILDING REVIEW

All existing facilities of the Paulsboro School District shall be evaluated annually for safety and structural soundness as required by law, and for suitability to the goals and objectives of the educational program.

The Superintendent shall include in the report to the board an itemization of all necessary repairs and alterations with their estimated cost, and suggestions for improved utilization of available space.

After the board has acted on the annual building review report, the Superintendent shall be responsible for making the necessary additions to the school district's Master Plan.
