Substitute Teachers must be licensed by the State of Nevada and complete school district employment paperwork. The State of Nevada requires a minimum of **62 semester credits, with 6 semester credits in professional education, or a bachelor's degree or higher degree** earned through a regionally accredited college/university, to be eligible for a K-12 substitute license. **A nonrenewable emergency substitute teacher license can be obtained with a high school diploma** and recommendation from the school district. The licensure application and information can be found on the Nevada Department of Education Web Site. Substitute teacher aides are required to have a high school diploma or equivalent, must be fingerprinted and complete district employment paperwork.
