EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS AND PREREQUISITES

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent; experience may substitute for education
- 2. Sufficient education/training in the installation, operations and repair of heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration systems
- 3. HVAC license is preferred
- 4. Five years of successful HVAC experience preferred; documentation of experience required
- 5. Working knowledge of electrical, plumbing and sheet metal trades as they relate to installing, repairing/servicing HVAC and refrigeration equipment
- 6. Working knowledge of high/low voltage electricity and its applications
- 7. Ability to diagnose/troubleshoot and repair various types of HVAC and refrigeration systems including, but not limited to: water source heat pumps, chillers, boilers, conventional split systems, mini split systems, package units and cooler and freezer units
- 8. Possess skills to develop interpersonal relationships with administrators, school staffs, and peers
- 9. Ability to communicate both verbally and in writing
- 10. Such other qualifications as may be set by the Board of Trustees

TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- 1. Perform a full range of tasks associated with installation, maintenance, and repair of heating, ventilation, air conditioning and environment control systems
- 2. Maintain and repair all HVAC equipment
- 3. Perform preventative maintenance on all HVAC and refrigeration systems
- 4. Clean units and change filters on a schedule
- 5. Maintain cleanliness of all areas around HVAC systems, chillers, boilers and air handlers
- 6. Maintain and repair all refrigerators, ice machines, walk-in coolers and freezers
- 7. Install, assemble and repair pumps, condensers, motors and other refrigerating equipment
- 8. Maintain and perform preventative maintenance on chillers and boilers
- 9. Repair/replace and calibrate HVAC and refrigeration components as needed
- 10. Perform a variety of facility maintenance tasks throughout the school district
- 11. Assist in the maintenance and repair of electrical systems, equipment and fixtures
- 12. Ensure all work, repairs and installations meet or exceed local, state and federal codes
- 13. Performs other duties as assigned
