Regardless of income, all families should complete the FAFSA annually because it is required for all federal financial aid and most state and institutional aid. To get started, go to [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov) to apply!

## FAFSA - Here's how it works:

1. Set up your personal Federal Student Aid ID (FAFSA ID) to access, complete, and submit the FAFSA online at [fafsa.ed.gov](http://fafsa.ed.gov)
2. Complete your application as soon as possible after the FAFSA start date each year you plan to attend college.
3. You will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) within three weeks of completing your FAFSA. The SAR is a summary of your aid eligibility and answers on the FAFSA form. It also includes your Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Review your SAR carefully to ensure it's correct and complete.
