# \$150 BILLION IN FEDERAL STUDENT AID IS AVAILABLE!

Regardless of income, all families should complete the FAFSA annually because it is required for all federal financial aid and most state and institutional aid. To get started, go to fafsa.ed.gov to apply!

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#### FAFSA - Here's how it works:

- Set up your personal Federal Student Aid ID (FAFSA ID) to access, complete, and submit the FAFSA online at fafsa.ed.gov
- Complete your application as soon as possible after the FAFSA start date each year you plan to attend college.
- 3. You will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) within three weeks of completing your FAFSA. The SAR is a summary of your aid eligibility and answers on the FAFSA form. It also includes your Expected Family Contribution (EFC). Review your SAR carefully to ensure it's correct and complete.
