

Advanced Placement (AP) Test

Advanced Placement (AP) tests are administered on QHS campus only when the AP course is offered at QHS during the corresponding school year. Currently Quitman High School offers AP English Language and Composition and AP English Literature and Composition on alternating years. This information is found in the Student Handbook. The dates and cost per test are set by College Board and is finalized and published every year. Information can be found at www.collegeboard.com. Homeschooled students who wish to take the AP tests at Quitman High School should contact the school counselor or student advisor no later than November 1 to register for a particular test. Payment is due one week prior to the scheduled test date. For more information, please contact the school counselor or advisor.

PSAT (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test)

The Preliminary SAT (PSAT) is administered on the QHS campus every year in October, usually on the 2nd or 3rd Wednesday. The cost of the test is approximately \$15. The date and cost is set by College Board and is finalized and published every year in the spring prior to the October test date. Information can be found at www.collegeboard.com. Homeschooled students who wish to take the PSAT at Quitman High School should contact the counselor no later than October 1 to reserve a test. Payment is due by the Wednesday prior to the test date.
