



The loading and unloading area is called the "Danger Zone". This area is 10 ft. from the front, both sides and back of bus. **This square perimeter is where children are in most danger of not being seen by the driver.**

REMEMBER-

- ✓ Arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes early
- ✓ Stand at least 5 giant steps (10 ft) away from the edge of the road
- ✓ Wait until the bus stops, the door opens and the driver says it is ok or gives you a thumbs up, before stepping on the bus
- ✓ You or a designated adult must come to the bus door to put your child on the bus and get your child off the bus

Behavior On the Bus-

There are three primary rules we expect our children to follow when they are on the bus. These rules are in place to ensure the driver can drive without distractions and your child can be transported safely to and from their school.

- ☺ Quiet/Inside voices at all times- NO TALKING when stopping at and crossing over railroad tracks
- ☺ Remain seated and in your harness until the driver states you may unhook yourself
- ☺ Hands and feet to self- not in the aisle, above your head or bothering your neighbor
