The LaSalle County Bar Association is now providing two \$500 Scholarships to two graduating seniors of any LaSalle County High School. These Scholarships are available for use at: a four year College or University, a two year College and/or a certified Trade School. The Association is honored to help aspiring young people pursue their studies to both improve as individuals and to contribute to their communities. The Scholarship is not automatically renewable. The award is for one year only and will be available to the next year's graduating classes.

The applications for this Scholarship program will be provided by the Bar Association to each LaSalle County High School through the Association or the LaSalle County Superintendent's Office of Education. The application DEADLINE is by close of business on Friday, April 20, 2018. The completed application must be mailed, sent or given to the LaSalle County Superintendent's Office.

Students must complete and sign all forms required. Objective factors for awarding the Scholarship will be considered by the Scholarship Committee of the Bar Association. Both merit and need will be among the criteria.

Students awarded the Scholarship must provide written proof of acceptance before receiving the award. The two \$500 rewards shall be provided to the students on or before May 15, 2018.
